

Student Officer Roles & Responsibilities

President

Serve as liaison between the National organization and the local organization. In addition, the President will

- supervise all student organization meetings;
- oversee the process of student organization event planning;
- complete all student organization purchase requests;
- submit all required paperwork for student organization renewal;
- hold a minimum of two meetings for the general membership per semester; and
- submit the semester and annual report of student organization activities

Vice President

The Vice President will

- supervise student organization meetings in the absence of the President;
- assist the President with the oversight of the student organization including fundraising, event planning, etc.;
- work with the student organization's Treasurer to prepare an annual budget;
- maintain a current accounting of the student organization's financial status, including income and expenses;
- schedule locations for meetings and events; and
- coordinate student organization fundraising efforts with the Treasurer

Treasurer

The Treasurer will

- prepare the annual student organization budget;
- monitor the student organization's budget;
- complete an annual financial report for the student organization;
- tend to the status of all purchase requests;

To pick, bag, and deliver fruit of all kinds to food banks, charities, other charitable organization, and directly to those who are needy.



- collect funds and depositing to the student organization's account;
- pay bills;
- keep a record of all transactions, i.e. deposits, checks and adjusting entries; and
- prepare monthly financial reports and documents to keep the student organization's membership informed about the student organization's financial situation.

Secretary

The Secretary will

- take minutes at every student organization meeting;
- maintain the student organization history for that academic year;
- verify all student organization purchase requests;
- assist with student organization projects where needed; and
- maintain communication between the student organization president and individual participants, include emails, letters, and phone calls
